Make bees happy!

"More than half of our important pollinators are threatened to disappear. They increasingly lack food sources and living space".

Since many years the allotment gardeners throughout Europe have been investing a lot of efforts to safeguard the bees.

Articles are regularly published in the allotment magazines, old and young people are sensitized, beehives are installed on allotment sites and training sessions in beekeeping are offered. In 2013 the Office issued a Vademecum concerning bees on allotment sites.

The allotment gardeners' efforts in this area are regularly honoured on Officelevel, last at the occasion of our 38th international congress in Vienna in August 2016. The diploma for innovative projects was awarded to the association "Blumenfreunde" in Vienna for their bee project.

The German allotment federation continues its efforts.



So now starts the first step of the federal competition **"Wir tun was für Bienen!"** (We become active for our bees). The German allotment federation is a cooperation partner of the initiative "Deutschland summt!" (Germany buzzes)

- who will present good examples taken from all three seasons online. The aim is to mobilize additional participants.

Following the idea that "in autumn you have to think about spring and plant plants flourishing in spring", the actors ask the people to become active now for the first period of the competition **Herbstsummen** (autumn buzz). The aim is to re-conquest as many areas as possible for wild- and honeybees.

Whether these areas are situated in the public domain, on green sites, industrial grounds, allotment or private gardens and even on a balcony: everywhere local plants should bloom for bees.
